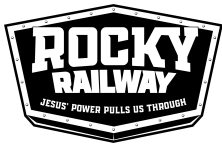

- Grade 1 and 2: Participate in creative activities while guiding and building relationships with Gr. 1, 2 kids.

- Grade 5 and 6: Participate in creative activities while guiding and building relationships with Gr. 5, 6 kids.
